

Kindergarten Weekly Overview

Week 1: March 16-20

Project	Build a Shelter for Percy
Writing	Students can write one informational story everyday (“teaching true facts”). They can write about animals they know and/or research animals on Nat Geo Kids https://kids.nationalgeographic.com/ (depends on your student, can take 20-35 minutes)
Reading	Read with your student 20 minutes every day. Have students practice reading and writing their “word worms”: he, away, must, no, by, there (about 5 minutes)
Math	Lessons 21-24 and daily math practice on Zearn (10 minutes a day minimum)
Religion	St. Patrick and St. Joseph worksheets
Science	Building Percy’s shelter, recording daily weather

Week 2: March 23-27

Project	Spring Headband
Writing	Students can write one informational story everyday (“teaching true facts”). They can write about animals they know and/or research animals on Nat Geo Kids https://kids.nationalgeographic.com/
Reading	Read with your student 20 minutes every day. Have students practice reading and writing their “word worms”. This week we are reviewing all the words from Unit 5.
Math	Lessons 25-29 and daily math practice on Zearn
Religion	Ch 19 Seeds are Good packet
Science	recording daily weather

Week 3: March 30-Apr 3

Project	Holy Week Crosses
Writing	Students can write one narrative story a day (“stories about my life”).
Reading	Read with your student 20 minutes every day. Have students practice reading and writing their “word worms”: do, down, just, little, only, went
Math	Lessons 30-34 and daily math practice on Zearn or Khan Academy
Religion	Ch 18 Meals are Good packet
Science	recording daily weather

Week 4: April 6-10--Spring Break! No school work this week

Week 5: April 13-17

Project	Don't Let the Pigeon Stay Up!
Writing	Students can write one opinion story a day ("how you think or feel but it isn't true for everyone"). Please see my example and lesson on Google Classroom.
Reading	Read with your student 20 minutes every day. Have students practice reading and writing their "word worms": ask, every, have, help, one, walk
Math	Lessons 35, 36, 37, 38, and 40 and daily math practice on Zearn
Religion	Ch 20 Butterflies are Good packet, Easter is Good worksheet
Science	recording daily weather

Week 6: April 20-24

Project	<i>Down by the Bay</i> rhyming book
Writing	Student choice! Students can pick which type of stories they would like to write this week.
Reading	Read with your student 20 minutes every day. Have students practice reading and writing their "word worms": look, out, put, saw, their, very
